DIRECTIONS TO CHAPTER MEETINGS

Our Lady of the Fields Catholic Church - 1070 Cecil Avenue, Millersville, MD - 410-987-1551

From Baltimore/Sev Park - Take 97 South toward Annapolis. Get off at Exit 7 (Route 3 South). Turn left on Millersville Road (Route 175). Go ½ mile and turn right on Cecil Avenue. The Church is ½ mile on right. Enter through door #3.

From Bowie/Crofton area – Take Route 3 North. Turn right on Millersville Road (Route 175) and follow directions above.

North County Library

From Annapolis, Severna Park and points south:

Go north on Route 2. Go through Severna Park and past the exits to Route 10 and Route 100. Stay on Route 2 approximately 2 miles. Go past Marley Station Mall and make a right at the next light past all the mall lights. There will be a Presbyterian Church on the right. Make an immediate left onto the road that parallels Route 2. Library is ¾ of a block on the right. Parking is in the rear.

From points west and northwest:

Take I-97 to Route 100. Exit at Route 2 North to Glen Burnie. Take Route 2 north following the directions above.

Butterfly Memory Boxes

Paints (Americana):

Light Buttermilk
Burnt Sienna
Ultra Blue Deep
Pansy Lavender
Lt. Hauser Green

Raw Sienna
Moon Yellow
Diox. Purple
Pine Green
Lamp Black

Supplies:

Regular painting supplies
Thin Liner Brush
#12 or #14 flat for shading
Small Stipple brush
Mop brush
Sharp Scissors
Scrapbooking paper — to cut out for the butterfly. (I will have some extra scrap-booking paper to chose from as well). I used three different papers — for the top wings, bottom wings and the center.

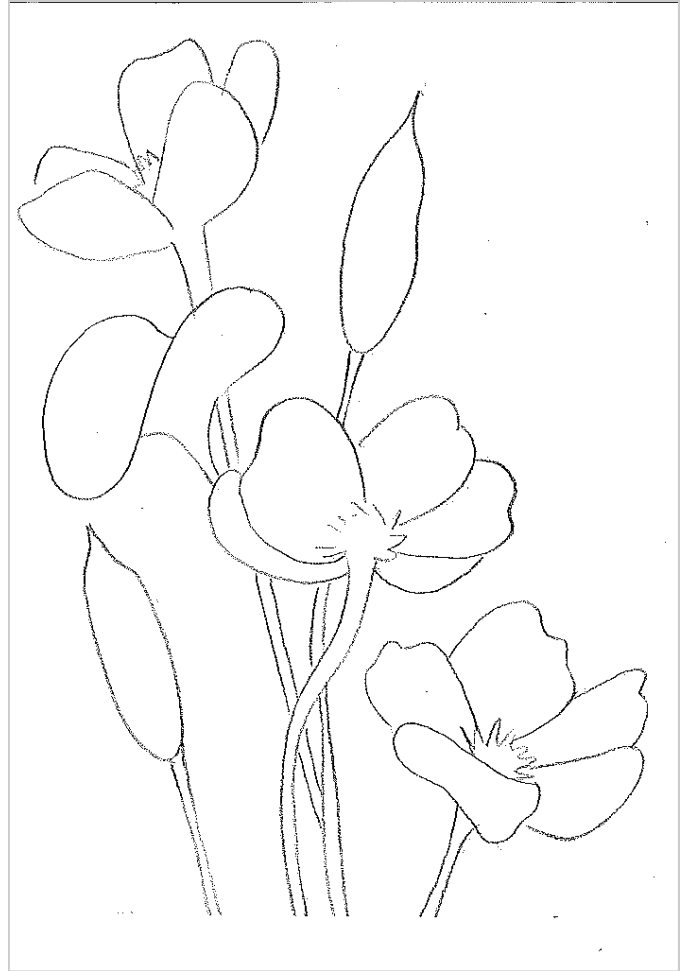
Preparation:

Basecoat the inside of the lid with 2 smooth coats of Light Buttermilk. Transfer the pattern for the flowers and leaves onto the left side of inside of the box (see picture).

If you want, you can line the bottom of the box with scrap booking paper as well, or paint it with one of the colors used for the flowers and leaves.

Note:

Other colors can be substituted for the flowers and leaves, depending on your preference.
